FIRE WARDEN/MARSHAL



A Fire Warden plays an important part of an organisations fire safety procedures. Organisations will usually appoint one or more people in each office, shift pattern or area to ensure coverage across the operational hours. A Fire Warden will work with the employer to ensure fire evacuation procedures are effective and will contribute to the fire prevention strategy.
